### Remembering Jack Miller

Co-Founder of Tencarva



**Jack Miller, Co-Founder and Former President, Tencarva,** passed away on September 1, 2022.

Jack was born on April 2, 1932 in Charlotte, NC. He was an engineering, ROTC graduate of North Carolina State University, where he was a member of Kappa Alpha Order. After college, Jack served in the Air Force as a fighter pilot for three years. Jack

met his wife Nancy on a blind date on New Year's Eve in 1958. They were married a year later.

He began his career working as a sales engineer for Tidewater Supply Machinery Division in Norfolk, Virginia. He stayed with the company for twenty years working in Norfolk, VA, Greensboro, NC, and Richmond, VA.

A change to the sales engineers' pay plan encouraged Jack and others to strike off on their own. In March of 1978, Jack teamed up with Vernon Cashwell, Dick Smith, Bill Stewart, and Bob Paschal to found Tencarva Machinery Company. Jack served Tencarva for the next 20 years, becoming president in 1990 and retiring at age 66 in 1998.

After retirement, Jack was active in investing and developing various real estate projects in Virginia and North Carolina. Jack and his family have enjoyed many years at their home on the water at Gwynn's Island, where he was always busy, fishing, boating, and gardening. He was a very active member of his community.

At his passing, Jack was 90 years old, was survived by his wife, Nancy; his son, John S. Miller Jr., and his wife, Carter Gibbs Miller; his daughter, Rebecca Miller Mahon, and her husband, Bernard Walton Mahon Jr. of Fredericksburg. He is also survived by his five grandchildren, Anna, Walton, Sutton Mahon, and Jack and Carrington Miller; and his sister, Marianna Miller Raugh of Hickory, North Carolina.

## 35 years of dedication to ESSCO

"At ESSCO, we put service before sales. Don was always saying, 'You've gotta take care of the customer.' Whatever the customer needed, he took care of it."

In Greensboro, Don eventually took over the sales management responsibilities. He knew the ins and outs of the entire operation. Jeff Johnson, current Sales Manager, ESSCO, marveled at the way Don became so much a part of the company: "He was passionate about ESSCO and loved to tell everyone about our expertise, what we did-he was good at that. I always joked with him that if I ever took anyone on a tour of our facility, it would take about 5 minutes. If Don took them, it was going to be 20-30 minutes."

Don worked under Stan Shelton, retired VP, ESSCO, at the beginning of his tenure in Greensboro. They worked together for about 25 years, and built a firm friendship. "Don always did

a really good job. He was very good at attention to detail but he couldn't read his own writing and neither could anyone else," Stan laughed, remembering Don's infamous chickenscratch. "He wrote down some stuff for a customer one time, brought it in to me and said 'Can you read this?'...He should have been a doctor."

Outside of work, Don was always a dedicated family man. His two daughters and one son grew up while he was at ESSCO and Don stayed busy driving to countless soccer games. Now he stays busy with his ten grandchildren. All his kids still live in North Carolina, so Don's passion and focus is on living the retired life and enjoying being a grandfather.

His retirement this year has made an impact on his coworkers, past and present. Debbie said, "We're all going to miss him. Don was a major part of ESSCO and with all of us—the old timers—retiring, ESSCO is definitely changing. It's the end of an era." After 35 years of supporting ESSCO, he's earned a happy retirement. Stan put it plainly: "Don's just a really good person."


#### **GRADUATION:**
